

Renovations to the original building in **1983**—Now a library upstairs with three classrooms downstairs. The school has **195 students**.



1952 Ursuline Sisters withdrew and the Lismore Presentation Sisters came.



The second school building opened **15th December, 1957** now numbering **156 students**.

At the end of **1987** the Presentation Sisters withdrew, first lay Principal was appointed.

Infants building opened **16th August, 1964** with **168 students**

This building was converted to a library, a classroom and a staffroom.

Double storey building opened **2nd December, 1979** with **269 students**.

On **Monday 27th August, 1917** classes for K-10 began with **60 students**. The school was officially opened on **16th September, 1917**.

1993— **420 students**. Years 5 and 6 moved to the new school at St James. In **1994** Year 4 was also taken to St James. St Joseph's catered for K-3. In **1997** built up to K-6 with **273 students**.

Our current school, upgraded in **2010** with **309 students**. Opened on **7th September, 2011** with **317 students**. In **2015** we have **335 students**.

Books and ordinary school requisites were in short supply. Children went to school barefoot and some rode horses. The seats and desks were still oily and stained the children's clothes and the rain came down in torrents.
